Thankful for Needs Met!

Here's a list of needs that have been met at our Mission in Mongolia:

Toner, cartridge, and computer chip for the digital press have arrived from America. Fuses for the cutter have arrived. Cup press and T-shirt press purchased for ministry use. Utilities funds sent. Workers' wages have been paid. Vacation Bible School (VBS) expenses covered. Mongolian children's books have been completed. Bible College curriculum is being printed. Translation team working on-site in our building for a month. Control board for our cutter located in Germany.

We are reaching out with an important request to help us secure Bible paper for printing the Mongolian Bible. This special lightweight paper, crucial for the project, isn't available in Mongolia and must be imported from China. We've arranged with a trusted



importer to include a skid of this paper in an upcoming shipment, which presents a unique opportunity to acquire it at a reduced logistical cost. The total cost to purchase and transport the paper is \$5,000. Your support would be invaluable in bringing this project to fruition, ensuring the continued availability of the Bible in Mongolian. Thank you for considering this vital contribution to our mission.

Mongolian Challenges

I am reaching out to you today with a heartfelt update on the challenges our team in Mongolia is facing due to severe inflation and recent political changes. Following the elections in early October, which resulted in a shift towards a more communistic government, we have seen immediate and significant increases in living expenses that affect everyone, especially our dedicated workers.

Starting November 1st, the cost of electricity rose by 26%, while heating-a necessity as the temperatures drop-has seen an astonishing 86% increase. Additionally, the cost of coal and wood, essential sources of heat for many Mongolian homes, has doubled. These changes add over a dollar each day to the expense of heating a home, a substantial burden for those who earn less than \$750 per month. This shift not only strains budgets but threatens the wellbeing and safety of our workers and their families as winter sets in.

These increases are also taking a significant toll on the wider community, particularly churches and senior citizens. Churches are struggling to manage these rising costs while continuing to serve and support their congregations. For senior citizens, many of whom live on fixed incomes, the increased expenses for basic utilities make it difficult to meet their essential needs.

In this challenging time, we are turning to our supporters for their continued prayers and generosity. Any assistance can help alleviate the stress on our team, allowing them to focus on their work with peace of mind and ensure that our churches and elderly community members canreceive the support they need. With your help, we can provide essential relief and bring hope to those who are hardest hit by these changes.

Thank you for standing with us through every challenge. Your compassion and generosity continue to be a source of strength and hope. Please keep our workers, churches, senior citizens, and their families in your prayers as we navigate these difficult changes together.


