Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

This is Robert Stover, missionary in Tacna, Peru, writing to update you again on the Tacna Christian School Project. I apologize for the delay in updating you all. We had planned to start the construction in August of this year, but had several problems with the architect. Thankfully, we were able to resolve the issues and were able to start on the construction two weeks ago.

Currently, the workers are advancing in the digging of the foundation, pouring the footers, and planting the rebar columns. The main foreman is a faithful member of one of the churches here in Tacna and has experience in many building projects. He has always done very good work, and we are thankful that he has volunteered to help us on the school project. We are uncertain at this point if we will be able to finish the needed construction and secure the necessary permits to start the daycare in March of 2025. It is our hope that things will continue smoothly and without delay in the coming weeks and months.

Thank you so much to those who have sent in special gifts as well as faithful monthly support for the school. To this point the money has helped (and will help) to cover the architect's fees, property taxes, accountant fees, the first order of materials, and the workers' salaries. Currently, we have seen close to \$53,000 come in of the \$105,000 needed for the first phase of construction. Our prayer is that \$15-20,000 more would come in to help us complete the footers, columns, walls, and stuccoing. This would allow us to put on a temporary metal roof as we wait for funds to complete the concrete roof. Of course, the Lord could allow all of the money to come in at once to be able to put on the concrete roof. The timing is in His hands.

We do ask you to continue to help us to pray for wisdom as we continue forward with the project. Please help us pray that the architect, engineer, construction foreman, and workers would have the discernment to spot and correct any potential errors in the design of the building. Our hearts are grateful for Bethany Homan and the dream that God put into her heart to have a Christian school in our city to train children in a Christian environment. Lord-willing, I will send out an update on the building project in the month of February. May the Lord grant each of you a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year!
