We come to you with hearts full of gratitude and hope as we press forward in the great work God has called us to – preparing the print shop in Mongolia for the upcoming printing of the whole Bible in the Mongolian language. The translation is on course to be completed by the summer of 2026, and we believe with all our hearts that God's Word will not return void, but will accomplish what He pleases. (Isaiah 55:11)

Your prayers and sacrificial giving have been a light along this journey, and we thank God upon every remembrance of you. (Philippians 1:3) Many of you have already given generously, and we are humbled by your faithfulness. Now, we find ourselves at a critical point where we must press toward the mark. The print shop needs updated equipment, walls installed, and air purifiers for the digital printing room. We have invested all that we have, yet several thousand dollars are still needed to cover these preparations, along with airfare to return to Mongolia by the end of April.
