God has been so gracious in these as well. The conference in Paraguay resulted in 147 salvation decisions and 48 baptisms. In Monterrey in February almost 1000 people came to the services with 90 pastors, missionaries, and assistants being challenged in their ministries. In Peru, 23 pastors attended, and in Ecuador there were 55 brethren that surrendered their lives to serve the Lord in full-time service. We are currently preparing to have two conferences next week. One will be in Campeche, Mexico, and the other in Venezuela. The third week will be our conference in San Cristobal de las Casas, Mexico, and the week after that will be one in the mountains of Guerrero. This one in Guerrero is challenging. Transportation is more difficult. But, there will probably be more people coming to the conference than live in that mountain town. It will be held in the open air for there is no building big enough to handle the crowd.
