In México, stray dogs are common in some areas (who, all things considered, are quite friendly), and dogs people own for security are also quite common. At the beginning of May, I had an interaction with a dog that was definitely a first. As I was approaching a door to knock on it, there was a medium to large-size dog that was well hidden right by the front door of his house. After I had approached him, I learned that he was not friendly and had enough leash to bring his unfriendliness to my ankles. I am thankful that I was able to keep Charity safe from his jaws, and I am also thankful that the Lord prevented the dog's teeth from getting through my socks or my skin.

After this rattling new experience, I am glad that the Lord allowed me to witness to Isabel a few doors later, and I am more grateful that she trusted Christ as her Savior. Please join me in praying for her husband and daughter to get saved, and that she and her family would start attending church. Also during May, I was able to lead Dante and Sandra to Christ. Please join me in praying for their growth as Christians as well.

I also want to let you know that we are beginning to plan a furlough starting in December of this year and ending in May of next year. We are doing this because inflated prices have proven to be a challenge here in México as well, and we want to be sure to be well-funded before we start our church so we can stay here with it through its early years so much as is possible.
