

One of these five is **Bameno**, about 125 miles into the Amazon jungle and our hosting pastor, Victor Gallo, knew nothing about this river community. The chief is open for Gallo to come back and teach them. God's providence used the weather and inquisitiveness to direct us to this location. It was NOT on our itinerary for the week.

Another highlight was going to **Toñapari**, where five missionaries were massacred in 1956 by Auca Indians (as known then). We stood on the actual sand bar (called "Palm Beach") where Jim Elliot and his colleagues died. We were on holy ground and took time to pray for God to raise up sacrificial laborers for His harvest.

Overall, we traveled by jet, by truck, by foot, by wooden canoe, and by small planes. We ate some simple meals, some great tasting river fish, and even "cuy" (roasted guinea pig). God kept us all healthy and safe the whole time, for which we are grateful.

His providence even worked in our need. In our last letter we informed you of God working wonderfully to provide us the funds to replace one of our cars. As amazing as the provision was, so was the purchase. We looked for a couple weeks, asking for God's direction. Our search kept bringing us back to a vehicle that was listed as "coming soon". But, it seemed like it was never coming. On the very morning that the car money was transferred to our bank and available, suddenly we were notified that the car was available. It was the very car that Robin had been praying for with "all the details": fair price in market, burgundy exterior, tan interior, NO SUN ROOF, and low mileage!
