Concerning Fires conferences, 65 pastors attended in Campeche, Mexico. In Venezuela, over 1000 people were present for evening services and by the

conference end 143 brethren surrendered for full-time service. In San Cristobal de las Casas, Mexico, almost 500 folks attended each night. The three conferences combined resulted in more than 480 people trusting Christ as Savior. We are so very grateful for God's presence, mercy, and wonderful working in hearts. This month of June, we also had conferences in Ontario, CA and Bartlett, IL. In Bartlett, I got to speak and translate seven times. There was real moving of hearts toward the Word of God during the week.

Please pray that God will supply the funds for Pastor Gallo to go back to Bameno. To travel on the river could take him 5 days. He could fly there in an hour or so, which would be the better option, but planes are more costly. Pray for coming conferences in Belize and Dominican Republic in July.
