As I write this correspondence, I'm about to fly out to Jacksonville, North Carolina, where I will preach the missions conference at the Maranatha Baptist Church. This will be my 12th conference with Pastor McConkey and the fine folks there. God has richly blessed this church, and they readily admit that it is mainly because of their commitment to worldwide missions and their diligent emphasis on soul winning. Being near Camp LeJeune, the church has a great outreach ministry to the Marines and their families, reaching many of them for Christ. In fact, some 50% of their present congregation are affiliated with the active-duty military and another 30% are veterans who have chosen to live in the area upon their discharge from the Marine Corps. It is, indeed, an exciting church! The 13 years Pastor McConkey has labored there their attendance has increased some 575%. During this same period their faith promise mission commitments has also risen over 500%. God continues to shower His blessings on them. They are presently in a building program constructing a 300-seat auditorium. Please pray for this great church.

We did not know what lay ahead of us and if we would be able to continue our missions ministry. But God has shown Himself Almighty once again, used the treatments to heal my cancer and is now allowing me to continue traveling and preaching His Word. Hallelujah!!! Joyce and I just returned from three wonderful meetings in Michigan and Indiana with four more for the rest of the year. You have been so faithful to pray for us, and we are deeply appreciative of your concern. We will keep on keeping on and fighting the good fight of faith as long as God gives us strength.

This past month Joyce and I traveled to South Carolina to attend my 60th year high school reunion. It was such a blessing to see my old classmates, rub elbows with them again and "catch up" on the past years. It was my privilege to speak briefly about *What Is Your Life* and just how quickly these years have flown by. It would do us all good to ask ourselves that question and take some personal inventory of our own life. We will soon be in Eternity and only what's done for Christ will matter. I am sure that in THAT DAY we will wish we had given Him more.

Please continue praying for our military missionaries. I'm glad to report that souls are being saved in our military churches around the world. Faith Baptist Church in Iwakuni, Japan, has almost achieved their goal of the \$800,000 project they have worked on now for many months. Hopefully, they will be able to build their new building soon. Please continue praying for a permanent pastor for Maranatha Baptist, Okinawa, Japan. Brother Chris Parker is doing a great job as Interim Pastor.
