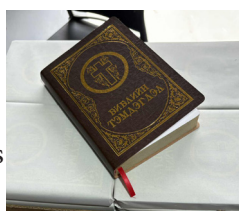

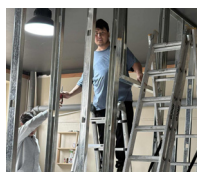
Bible Journal Project

Our first project was to test whether we could produce a full Bible in our shop. To do this, we created a Bible journal – 896 pages printed on 40 gram Bible paper, stitched, with gilded and rounded edges, and finished with an embossed leather cover. The result was beautiful, with the look and feel of a Bible itself. Praise the Lord, the answer is clear: we can print a Bible in Mongolia! As soon as the Mongolian Bible translation is complete, we are ready to go straight to press. God is so good.



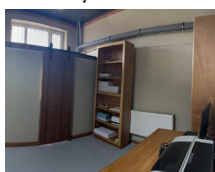
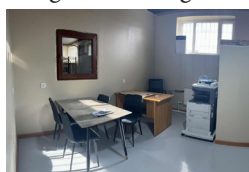
Building for the Future in Mongolia

During our time in Mongolia, we were blessed to make several important improvements to our mission property. As many of you know, Mongolia suffers from very poor air quality—especially during the long winter months. To help protect our equipment, we built a special room for our digital and electronic devices.



This new digital room allows us to use air purifiers, which will greatly extend the life of our computers, digital press, and other equipment that are essential tools for producing the Word of God in this region. We were also able to remove two unused outbuildings from our compound. By doing so, we have opened space for a future garage—a much-needed addition in a

land where the climate is harsh and the winters can be severe. Having a protected place for our vehicles will help us continue traveling and serving effectively throughout the year.



Press and Cutter Progress



In just three months, our new press ran nearly 400,000 impressions! It is running beautifully, producing full color at high speed – what a blessing. However, as many of you know, we have been without a functioning cutter for almost a year. After

sending the computer board to Michigan for repair, the cutter continued to struggle when we returned. God answered our prayer. On our very last day in Mongolia, a man in Ulaanbaatar was able to repair one final connection – and the cutter came back to life! *“With God all things are possible”* (Matthew 19:26).



Financial Needs

Our monthly budget for maintaining our building and compound in Mongolia is \$2,000. This includes essential upkeep, utilities, and the operation of our ministry shop that serves the local community. Any help you may have toward this need would be greatly appreciated. 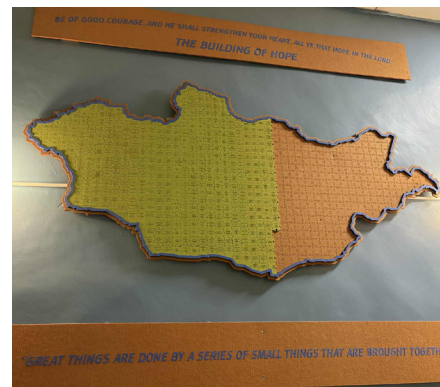
