We are grateful for your prayers and financial support. You are an integral part of the ministry here in Peru, and we are very thankful for the opportunity to serve Him together!



Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

Thank you for your prayers, gifts, and support of the Tacna Christian School Project. Each passing day brings us closer to the completion of the first phase of construction. Just recently, the temporary metal roofing was installed, the electrical connections were advanced, and the drop-ceiling was completed. Within the next few weeks, we plan to have the classrooms primed and painted and the doors and windows installed. It is a blessing to see the work advancing for the glory of God!

Please pray that God would provide the teachers and administrative personnel for the school. While our desire was to get all the paperwork and inspections done in time to get our license from the Department of Education to be able to begin this March, we were not able to acquire the school's permit. There is still the possibility that the school could start in 2026, but under the operating license of another small Christian school in our city. Please pray as we make decisions concerning these matters in the days ahead.

A pastor recently wrote and asked for some specific projects that they could help with. With the help of Pastor Henry Sucapuca, we have complied a list of specific items (projects) that are still needed:
