Want to Contact Us? 865-274-1645 gojcp@icloud.com During our three weeks in Ethiopia and Kenya, we witnessed God moving powerfully and unforgettably... from rural villages to the bustling streets of Addis Ababa, from the growing community of Dukem to the heart of Nairobi. The Lord allowed us to strengthen pastors, encourage churches, and open new doors for long-term Great Commission partnerships across continents. Our trip began at the East Africa Baptist Mission gathering, where I preached to pastors and believers from across the region. As we heard worship rise in several languages, we were reminded that the Gospel is advancing in places most will never see... yet where God is clearly at work.

From there, we helped launch Duke Faith Baptist Church in Dukem. We also spent a week teaching Discipleship and Ecclesiology to more than 40 pastors from Ethiopia and South Sudanese refugee camps, many of whom serve under challenging conditions. Their hunger for the Word reaffirmed our conviction that training national leaders can multiply the impact of the Gospel for generations. The week concluded with a joyful Ethiopian celebration, complete with the traditional "fatted goat." We also attended the dedication of the new Early Intervention Center at the Victory School for the Deaf in Addis Ababa, where the children's singing displayed how the Gospel transforms individuals, families, and communities in both spoken and signed languages. In Langano, I preached at the Philadelphia Baptist Church before joining believers in fellowship under a large tree... a great reminder of the unity we share in Christ.

One of the most urgent needs we encountered was the lack of Study Bibles for pastors who have no online options for studying. For about \$30, we can place a quality Study Bible in Amharic or Dinka into a pastor's hands. We also met pastors serving in remote regions who would greatly benefit from bicycles, which cost about \$150 and will allow them to reach their communities more effectively. If you would like to help with the purchase of "Bibles or Bicycles" for these faithful pastors, please let us know.

Mid-trip, a God-arranged connection occurred when our Bolivian friend, Osmar, told us his brother-in-law, Aquiles, was also in Ethiopia. Meeting him opened immediate connections with our Ethiopian partner, Pastor Berhanu, and created new ministry opportunities in both Ethiopia and Latin America. This unexpected moment reminded us of how God weaves hearts together for His purposes and strengthened our resolve to make a meaningful difference for Christ wherever He opens a door.

We then traveled to Nairobi, where we met with pastors and missionaries from across Africa and Asia. We attended the S4 conference, which strengthened our ministry networks and confirmed our core mission: equipping national pastors and leaders to multiply disciples in their own cultures.

And while **Latin America remains our primary focus**, we are deeply grateful for the additional doors God continues to open around the world as we invest in equipping leaders and church planters.
