We were able to raise \$1,200 towards the camp property through an activity that we had with our team of churches on November 1. God has provided close to half of the money needed to purchase the property (approximately \$5,000 is still needed). There were 15 visitors who came over the two days. We pray God will work in hearts through the presentations of the Gospel that were given. We were able to distribute gifts to more than 40 children who attend our church. It was a great time with many people working together.

We appreciate your continued prayers and support for the Tacna Christian School Project. In the past 2 months, all of the painting projects have been completed as well as various electrical projects. The windows have begun to be installed, and this should be completed sometime close to the beginning of the year. Quite a bit of the construction debris has been cleared, making the property look much nicer.

In the past letter, we discussed the possibility of the school functioning under the license of another Christian school. It seems that this is not going to be possible, but we are advancing with the idea of a daycare or an after-school program where Bible lessons would also be taught. Pastor Henry Sucapuca is meeting with someone at the Department of Education in these days to continue to check on the paperwork needed to begin.

Calvary Baptist Church recently had a Christmas outreach at the school, and many children and parents attended. With God's blessing, there has definitely been a positive response from the people who live near the school property.

A faithful supporting church recently paid for many of the things that were on the list of needs for the school. Other offerings will be directed to wherever the greatest need lies. The current needs are to better the security fence and to hire a night watchman. Thank you to those who have given in these months.
