This changes things for me, as she will be going into her local jails and being a busy pastor's wife, so naturally she cannot travel with me any longer. I truly believe God brought them together and I am happy for them both. That being said, I am still going into prisons, jails, and I am busy trying to get into more jails. I have had a meeting with a local jail chaplain so hopefully he will let me come in and have a bible study with those ladies. I will be going into a large prison once a month. I also will be a substitute for Mrs. Peggy Ellis in a large prison in Tennessee and I am looking forward to that. I am pursuing more opportunities, and I request your prayers for more open doors to declare the gospel.

Also, in December we were allowed to give out full Rock of Ages King James Bibles in a large facility. Thank you to ALL who gave to purchase these bibles! We gave out about 470 bibles to the inmates there and it was a huge blessing. Please pray that those who received them will read them and be saved. The Word of God has power and so does your prayers.

January was a slow month. I went to a special meeting that Rock of Ages has every year for pastors and their wives. I am neither one, but I enjoyed the preaching and gleaned so much from the lady's sessions. Sometimes we just need to be refreshed.

In February we were in Fulton County jail, and we spoke to eighteen ladies in two pods. One lady called on the Lord for salvation. Praise His name. One Sunday morning I went to my local jail and filled in for another woman. It worked out that I only miss Sunday school at my church, so I was able to make it to the preaching service. That Wednesday I was back at the same jail. There is such a need in the jails for the gospel. We had a record attendance of twenty-six ladies and two were saved. Hallelujah!!

On March 1st I was in a large prison in Georgia, and we also had a record attendance of eighty-six ladies. No one got saved but I believe they all were helped.

In January I lost a big portion of my support, but I know the Lord will take care of me. I just want to be transparent so that you can better pray for me. Thank you all for your continued prayers. I couldn't do it without each and every one of you.
