Dear Pastor and Church Family,

We pray this letter finds you well and encouraged. As we move further into the year, we continue to see God faithfully at work, meeting both practical and financial needs, providing direction, and raising up people to step into His calling. We are grateful, as always, to walk this journey together with you.

This month, we are especially excited to share about Denver and Angelli Florece. They have been serving as assistant pastor at Hope for the past couple of years and have now committed to stepping forward in faith to begin a new church in *Sta. Maria, Bulacan*. Over the past months, they have been faithfully gathering a small group of families for home Bible studies. What began quietly has grown a group of families, individuals and children that are each eager for fellowship, truth, and spiritual growth. There is a clear sense that God is beginning something special, and they are now prayerfully working toward establishing a new church.

At the same time, Denver and Angelli continue to oversee the day-to-day lives of the aging-out youth in the Pamana Project of Bahay Sibol, providing guidance and mentorship to kids preparing for adult life. They are faithfully carrying both callings: discipling within Sibol while also planting a new church. In the midst of this season, God has blessed their family with the arrival of their second baby girl, a beautiful reminder of His goodness and the joy of growing both a family and a ministry.

In addition to regular monthly support for Denver's family, one of the most immediate needs is the purchase of land for a future church building. While they are currently meeting in homes, there is a clear vision for a permanent place where this growing group can gather, worship, and reach the community. Please pray with Denver and Angelli:

- For wisdom and time management
- For the families—that their faith would deepen and grow
- For God's provision of land in His perfect timing
- For the church to be firmly rooted in truth and a light in the community

We are also looking ahead with anticipation as we welcome ministry teams for 2026 and 2027, with two teams already scheduled for this summer. These visits are not one-sided, but times of shared ministry, encouragement, and mutual strengthening—walking closely together in what God is already doing.

For those who come, there is a deepening of faith and perspective. For our churches, children, staff, and local communities, there is encouragement, connection, and the reminder that they are part of a much larger family in Christ. The opportunities to serve and be blessed are wide and varied. Each visit is shaped around the unique gifts and strengths of the team, with opportunities such as building projects, ministry in schools and youth groups, time with the children at Bahay Sibol, Bible distribution, youth camps, Bible clubs, and Vacation Bible School. Often, it is the simple moments—conversations, shared meals, and time together—that leave the most lasting impact. For many who have partnered with us for years, seeing the work firsthand brings a deeper meaning and perspective to that shared ministry.

As we look ahead, we would love to see more churches begin planning a visit. There is meaningful space for partnership for those who desire to serve, grow, and be part of what God is doing in the Philippines. If your church or group is interested, we would be glad to connect with you.
