The Lord has already provided a strong foundation through a cabin on our property that is well suited for this purpose, though it will require a complete remodel. We are also thankful that a sister printing ministry in Florida has granted permission to allow us to translate and print 150 books they hold the rights to. By God’s grace, four titles are already in progress.

With so few Christian resources available in Mongolia, our desire is to provide (along with the Word of God) books that encourage, equip, and strengthen believers across the country. Thank you for your continued prayers as we seek the Lord’s direction and financial provision.

Help with our Truck!

As we shared earlier, our Ram 2500 has been experiencing serious engine trouble, including low compression in one cylinder. Recently, the situation became much more urgent. After a Sunday evening service, we discovered our Honda CRV was missing and reported it stolen. While waiting, we called our son to pick us up with the truck—only for the truck’s engine to shut down completely on the way. Though it will still start, there is clear internal damage.

We later learned the CRV had been taken by mistake and were thankful to recover it the next morning. However, the truck remains in critical condition.

We are now in need of a rebuilt engine for our Ram 2500. This truck is essential to our ministry, as it pulls our camper and enables us to travel to churches across the country to share the work God is doing among the people of Mongolia.

We rejoice in the Lord for His gracious provision! Through the generosity of faithful supporters, a vital piece of equipment has been purchased for our print shop—an important step toward completing the full Bible printing process. We clearly see God’s hand in this blessing.

The equipment was shipped from China in December and has safely arrived in Mongolia. We plan to travel there in late February to install and test the machine, ensuring it is ready for effective use in the work of the Gospel.

The cost of airfare for this trip is approximately \$4,000. We are trusting the Lord for financial provisions for this need.

Thank you for standing with us as we labor to place the Word of God into the hands of the Mongolian people. Your partnership is a tremendous blessing.

Such support would be a tremendous blessing and a vital part of sustaining this work as we labor to reach souls for Christ.

Thank you for your prayers, encouragement, and faithful partnership in the work of the Lord.



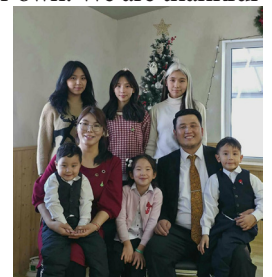
