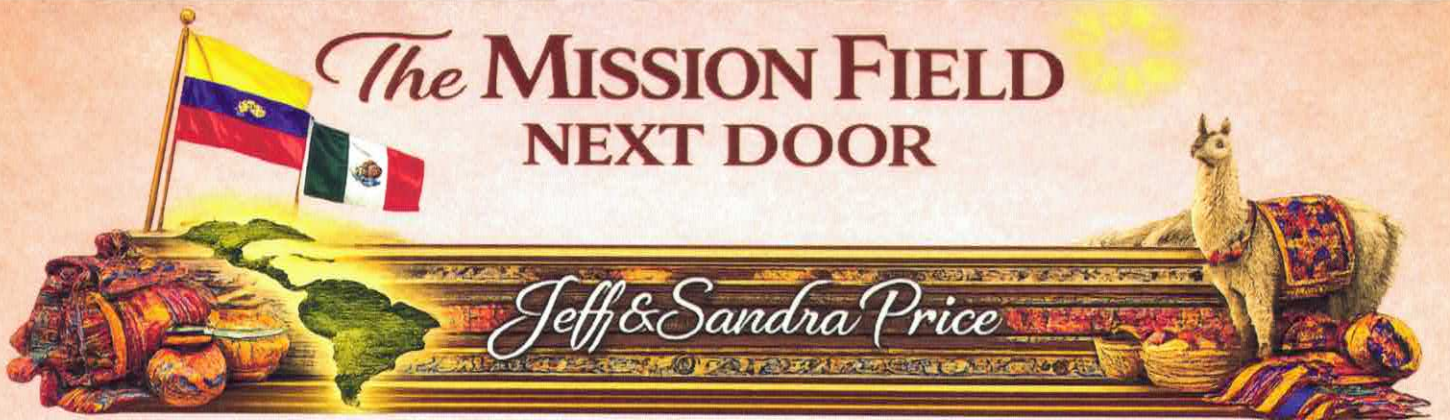


The MISSION FIELD NEXT DOOR

Dear Friends and Partners,

The Lord continues to open remarkable doors for ministry, and we are deeply grateful for your prayers, encouragement, and faithful partnership in the work He has entrusted to us.

Through our Pastors Network, which now serves pastors in 10 countries throughout Latin America—including the recent addition of Honduras—we provide pastoral counseling, biblical training, conferences, and ministry support to church leaders across the region. We are also exploring an open door in Mexico that could soon become the eleventh country in this growing network. As you may remember, this ministry began during the COVID years to encourage pastors facing isolation and ministry challenges and has grown from a simple effort into a network for encouragement, training, and ministry collaboration.

A key part of this Great Commission work is the training of pastors and ministry leaders. Through our partnership with Louisiana Baptist University, we are helping provide biblical and theological education to Christian workers in Latin America and beyond, equipping leaders in over 50 nations to faithfully preach the Gospel and strengthen churches in their communities.

Health Update - After recent ministry trips across four continents, Jeff's back issues worsened, and he has undergone two unrelated minor surgeries. Soon afterward, Sandra suffered a fall and broke her shoulder. We would greatly appreciate your prayers for healing and strength. Even in this season, the Lord continues to open opportunities to invest in pastors and ministry leaders across Latin America.

Bolivia Ministry - The work in Bolivia continues to move forward as the churches we partner with continue to grow. We are pursuing the purchase of a permanent building for one of last year's church plants, though new government regulations have slowed the process. Recently, torrential rains also destroyed the meeting place of another church plant, and we are working to secure a new location. Please pray that both needs will be resolved soon so that these church plants can continue to shine as lights for the Gospel in their communities.

Future Vision- Our Bolivian ministry partner, Sergio Saravia, will soon spend three months in Manila training under the camp ministry model developed by Global Surge. Our prayer is to establish an evangelistic youth camp in the heart of South America, where young people can hear the Gospel, grow in Christ, and be challenged to serve the Lord.
