

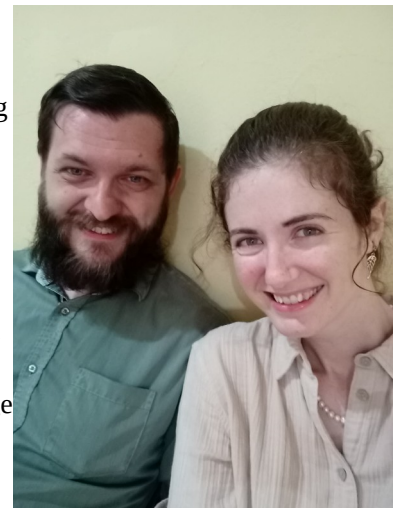


## April 2026

We had a great and busy April. I was able to get a lot of outreach done, handing out close to 2,000 invites a week, while also being able to have lots of good conversations with people. I have begun to develop something of an outreach route. I know where and when buses drop people off for work. Honduras is a cash society, and many bills are paid by going to a bank, which means long lines forming right before opening hours so, if I'm fast, I can usually distribute invites outside of two or three banks.

God is blessing our efforts as we have had a visitor come two Sundays in a row and he is planning on coming back again. This man is very interested in spiritual things and is asking a lot of questions, which is very encouraging for us. Please pray that this would be just the beginning and that we would have consistent growth for our church this year.

This month has not been without its obstacles. One Sunday on our way to church as we were going up a hill our car began to sound strange and had trouble accelerating. After driving it around a bit, I thought it might be the brakes and maybe something got a bit bent or stuck under the car. Turns out something was a "bit bent." Three bolts holding up the engine had snapped and the engine sunk down half a foot. Thankfully not too much damage was caused, we didn't get in a wreck, and Tegucigalpa has good public transport, so I was still able to do outreach. Thankfully, the repairs didn't take long but the day the car was done I got a bad stomach bug that put me out for a few days. Glad to be better now and seeing God bless our ministry!
