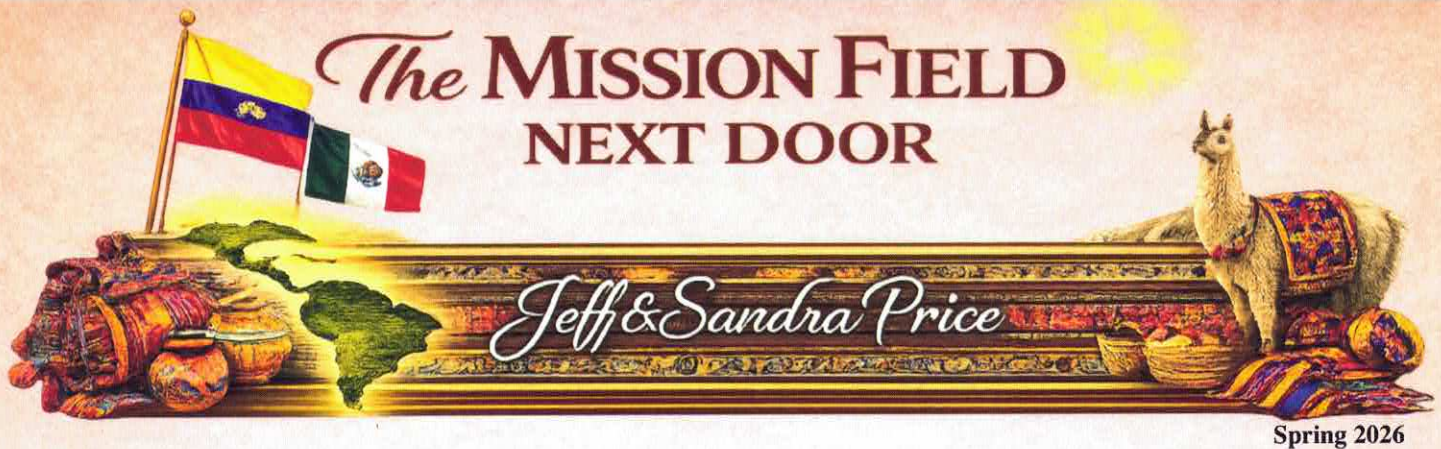




Spring 2026

When we think about missions, we are reminded that God is always doing far more than we can see. While statistics and reports are encouraging, what truly excites us is watching the Lord open doors, connect people, and expand His kingdom in ways that only He can.

One of those exciting opportunities is unfolding right now in the Philippines. Sergio, one of our key ministry partners in Latin America, is currently in Manila studying ministry models and outreach strategies to help us strengthen and expand our efforts. It is encouraging to see leaders from different parts of the world learning from one another so that more people can hear the Gospel.

Recently, Jeff had the opportunity to teach in our home church before traveling to Baptist International Outreach's Annual Enrichment Week for missionaries. During that week, he was able to invest in both new and veteran missionaries. One session focused on the realities of missionary life and ministry, helping newer missionaries prepare for the opportunities and challenges that lie ahead. Perhaps our most exciting news is from Santa Cruz, Bolivia. After much prayer, planning, and God's provision through His people, we have purchased a building for the new church ministry that was established last year. What was once only a vision has now become a reality. This facility will serve as a launching pad for the Gospel; it will be a place where people can hear God's Word, be discipled, and become part of a local church family. Every brick and every wall represents lives that will be touched by the transforming power of Jesus Christ for years to come.

The Lord is also continuing to expand our pastoral network throughout Latin America. What began as ministry in a handful of locations has now grown into a network spanning 10 nations with an 11th on the horizon. We are continually amazed at how God brings together pastors and ministry leaders who share a passion for reaching their communities and training the next generation of leaders. These relationships are multiplying opportunities for church planting, leadership development, and Gospel advancement throughout the region. We don't yet know what the future holds... but the horizon mentioned above looks promising.

As we look ahead, the remainder of 2026 will be filled with extensive travel, both across the United States and internationally. Each trip represents opportunities to strengthen partnerships, encourage pastors and missionaries, develop leaders, and open new doors for ministry. While the schedule is demanding, we are excited because every mile traveled is ultimately about reaching people with the Gospel and helping churches fulfill the Great Commission.

Thank you for standing with us through your prayers, encouragement, and financial support. Everything described in this letter is possible because faithful partners like you have chosen to invest with us in God's work around the world. We are grateful beyond words. Together, we are seeing God do great things. The fields truly are white unto harvest, and we are grateful to labor alongside you.
