Tacna Christian School Project

Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

We are so very thankful for your continued prayers and support. Since our last update, the interior doors and the security fence have been completed. We continue the process of obtaining the necessary permits, and ask for your prayers for Pastor Henry for wisdom and favor as he advances on this. We need to present the paperwork by August, so that we can undergo inspections and be approved for the school to open for the new school year in March of 2027.

One pending project is developing the exterior, which will be the playground area. If it were possible, we would like to develop the area of a full-sized soccer court. The total cost, which would include the installation of synthetic grass and a metallic structure to support the shade netting, would be just over **\$15,000**. It would definitely be beneficial to have the entire area done, so as to have a large space for assemblies or special days. We are trusting God to provide if it is His will and striving to use the money He has provided with wisdom.

We are also hoping to put aside money into an escrow account, so that before the first school year begins, we would have sufficient for teacher and administrative salaries for the first year. The total amount for that would be about \$25,000, but we think if we were able to have **\$10-15,000 saved by March of 2027** it would be a big blessing.

This will be the final prayer letter where we will mention the Tacna Christian School project by that name. It has been decided that the school will be named **Homan Christian School** in honor of missionary Bethany Homan who worked so hard to see the school opened. God burdened her heart for the young people of Tacna, and we know that she will be rejoicing in heaven to see the school finally opening and striving to provide quality Christian education in our city.
