



Ministry Update from EOW Ministries

June 2026

Greetings from EOW Ministries where we strive to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the men and women of Law Enforcement. (LE)

It's hard to believe but this July, 2026 will start the 4th year since the first cookout was held at my house for the Ludington Police Department.

Since then God has continued to open doors, shut doors, and pave the way for His Gospel to be given and the love of His son Jesus to be shown. At times it has been a slow step-by-step process, and at others I have barely been able to hang on to the fast-moving train!

Since we have begun raising support in June of 2025, we have continued to focus on providing for the physical and spiritual needs of police officers. From May of 2025 to December of 2025 we invested \$11,065.34 into cookouts, snacks, one-on-one coffees, officer gift bags, and marketing. We have created Gospel tracts, discipleship booklets, and business cards containing a direct message and challenge to police officers.

We also had two guest speakers come in for an officer appreciation night where we saw three officers raise their hands to acknowledge they had asked God to forgive them of their sin and save them.

EOW has also had the privilege of partnering with several local churches at multiple events by providing support as servers, workers, and just being available to love on cops. In return EOW has provided a full day of medical and security training for all the local churches' security teams to attend. This will be an annual event along with providing site security assessments and resources for church security teams. This partnership is vital to the ministry as officers will need discipleship once they have accepted Christ in order to grow spiritually.

In December of 2025 we were able to get enough support to do the Officer Gift Bags for the second year in a row. Over \$8,000 was raised to make sure every officer in Mason County, MI was taken care of. The bags included snacks, a \$50 gift card, and a clear presentation of the Gospel. This included local Police, Sheriff Deputies, Correction officers, State Police, and those in administrative roles. We were even able to take care of the Manistee Police Department with additional bags.

I have been regularly meeting with officers, LE Supervisors, and pastors to support and pray for them and their needs. I have been actively involved in keeping in touch with officers to support and pray for them. I have also completed his first “Emergency Response Counselor” training with the Billy Graham Institute and will be striving to complete the Emergency Response Chaplain course in an effort to increase my ability to help officers in need. I have also been doing ride-alongs with officers and attending SWAT training to provide food, spiritual support, and even a target to shoot at with their simunitions.

This year, 2026, we have seen God start to grow EOW with the purchase of an enclosed trailer. This trailer has been a game changer for supporting LE as we use this as a mobile command center to minister to officers. The trailer has been decaled with our ministry logo, complete with scripture and a QR code leading people directly to our FB, donation, and website page. The trailer was driven up to Camp Grayling in May for SWAT week where the team was treated to hot lunches for the week instead of cold sack lunches. The trailer also made it to the Blessing of the Bikes event in Baldwin where we fed over 90 first responders and support personnel. In every lunch bag we made, we placed our business card containing the gospel. thoseFor who came through our station we were able to engage in conversations, hand out Bibles, and pray with them. (We have already been asked to come back to both events next year!)

Most recently we responded with the SWAT team on a call out late at night and provided drinks, snacks and a meal for over 30 personnel on the call out. Officers are starting to let the love we are showing them sink in. As we continue to faithfully show up, it becomes easier to communicate the reason we are doing this.

In March of 2026 we had our first ever accredited training for officers and their wives. We had trainers from North Carolina cover ‘Officer Wellness’ and had a wonderful response. Five departments were represented, 23 officers and 9 spouses. Each officer received 2 hrs of training credit with the state of Michigan, and one of them even won an AR-15. This fall we plan on having a follow-up training for married couples.

EOW is currently in its 9th week of having a Bible study at the Mason County Sheriff’s Office. Sheriff Cole has opened up his department to us, and we have three deputies that have been faithfully attending.

We have also purchased some equipment that the departments do not necessarily have the budgets for, and have made the equipment available for use. God has laid on my heart that this is another avenue to show up huge for these guys, and we plan on creating a campaign to purchase additional equipment.

We are still actively seeking churches who would like to become a part of our monthly support as I am still working at Visscher Construction part time to help with family expenses. Several local churches support EOW in other ways such as hosting events, providing workers, and even donating prizes for drawings. However, having a budget to count on could free me up to go into the ministry full time. Currently we are at 30% of the support needed to do that.

We are confident in the provisions of God to complete the task He has set us to do. We have seen so many blessings every day as He continues to prepare us to do His work.

Please continue to pray for us and the officers we are sent to witness to. Pray God will continue to allow us to serve those who serve, and open up doors when we are supposed to walk through them.

Every day I count it an honor to serve my King! I am beyond grateful for the support and prayers of so many who have a passion to see cops get saved and grow in their relationship with Christ.
