

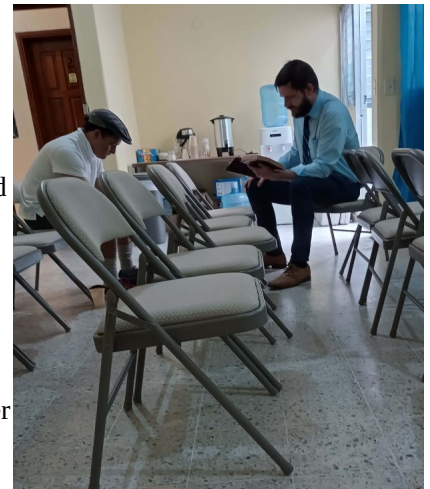


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We are celebrating a new milestone as we are continuing to see God bless our church plant. We had three people on one Sunday! Yes, three is not a lot but it is more than we have had so far. It feels great to prepare a sermon that you know people will hear. Right now, we have 5 people that are attending services consistently, but we have yet to get them all in one service. Another new growth at church is a ladies Bible Study that Amber has been doing right before our midweek service. We want to thank you for praying for our girls; we have seen two major answers to prayer in their lives recently. One is that Sofia in particular is growing in her Spanish. She is always excited to have visitors at church but she is often frustrated when she doesn't know a word she wants to say, so we have been praying for her. We want our children to flourish here and be very comfortable in both the culture and language, so we are blessed to see them growing in their Spanish. Please help us continue to pray for that.

A second thing we want to praise the Lord for is improvement in Elianna's health. Back in March we received some concerning news at a doctor's visit regarding a growth on her skin and were told it could indicate dangerous tumors growing in her brain, eyes, and other internal organs. Her chances of needing intense rounds of medication were high, and that would be just to manage symptoms, not a cure for the root cause. She has been through multiple exams since then, and over and over has left the appointments with doctors shaking their heads saying, "I'm surprised to say her heart/eyes/brain look perfectly normal for a baby her age. There are no tumors." She has one more exam left, and if she clears that as well, she will have a clean bill of health. Her doctor has told us that this is mostly routine, and she doesn't expect us to find anything of concern in this exam either. We are already praising the Lord for His goodness and mercy to us.

The last few months have been filled with many prayers and at times very heavy hearts as we navigated this, but the Lord is already using this difficulty to work good: last week Amber was chatting with a neighbor and had Ellie in the baby carrier; the neighbor commented on Ellie's skin and began to share with Amber that she and her husband had lost a daughter to this syndrome at 18 months old. They had a long conversation, and she and Amber are planning to get together for coffee and get to know each other better. Perhaps the plan all along was for us to meet these neighbors and connect with them. Please pray for our ongoing relationship with them, and that God would use us to bless them.
